Peli rigonfi ed agglutinati concentrati alla base del collo, ma alcuni più corti ed isolati sparsi sulla restante superficie. (p. 939) Podospora dakotensis

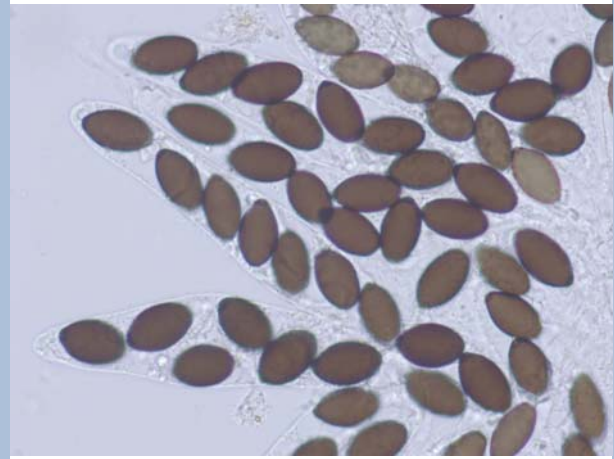

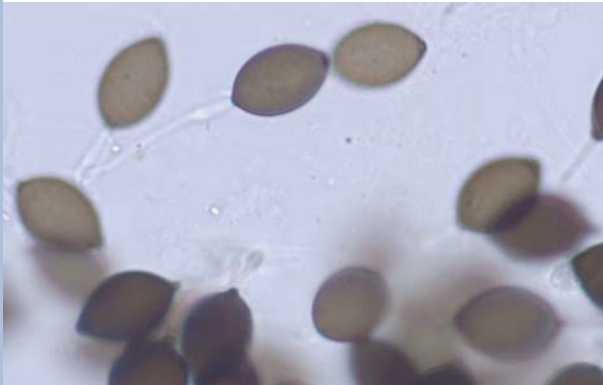
